## FROM THE SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR DEACON WAYNE WEILER

"Be doers of the word and not hearers only..." James 1:22

We will soon celebrate Independence Day. A day we give special thanks for the courage and commitment of our founding fathers for the cause of liberty, and to all who have died in defense of that cause. Our founders understood that an important tenant of a well-ordered and just society would be the freedom of its citizens to express their belief in God and to put that faith into practice in the everyday circumstances of life. How blessed we are to live in these United States of America where life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness matter.

The Church continues to ask us to remain vigilant in the protection of one of our most cherished, and dare I say threatened, liberties-religious freedom. The Catholic Bishops of the United States have asked that we reflect on what we may often take for granted—the freedom to express our faith without fear of persecution. But regrettably, we see far too many instances of a gradual erosion of this precious and protected gift. And in parts of the world we see painful images of an all-out assault on Christians, for no other reason than their faith in Christ, our Brother and Savior.

The Second Vatican Council document *Dignitatis humanae*, the Declaration on Religious Liberty, declares, "that the human person has a right to religious freedom. This freedom means that all men are to be immune from coercion on the part of individuals or of social groups and of any human power, in such ways that no one is to be forced to act in a manner contrary to his own beliefs, whether privately or publicly, whether alone or in association with others, within due limits. The council further declares that the right to religious freedom has its foundation in the very dignity of the human person as this dignity is known through the revealed <u>word of God and by reason itself.</u> "(DH #2)

St. James teaches us to be "doers" of the Word. This requires us to have the courage to put our faith into everyday <u>ACTION</u>. We can do so by expressing that faith though our system of government. In letting our voice be heard, voting our conscience, writing to our elected officials, and standing up for the poor and vulnerable we show the impact of our Christian values on a confused and often misled culture. These are all ways we can bring our faith to the public square for the common good and the good of all of God's creation.

Let us pray always for those persecuted for their walk with Christ, stand firm in our faith, and embrace the truth as revealed by God. We are called to live our faith in all facets of life-to hear the word of God and live it by our Piety, Study and Action. In these we are "doers" of the Word.

## **Sponsor Guidelines**



## Speak to God about a person before speaking to a person about God



To be a Sponsor is a privilege, and as such, carries a serious Christian responsibility. Sponsoring a friend for the Cursillo is not a haphazard circumstance. It should be a deliberate act to bring Jesus Christ into the world. Therefore, you must know your candidate and consider the important items below.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATE SELECTION**

- An adult Catholic (18+) who is able to receive the Sacraments and emotionally mature to understand the evangelical message and commit to it
- ♣ Able and willing to influence others in a Christian way
- ⊕ Be free of unusual stress, e.g., recent loss of a loved one (out of respect for the candidate and in courtesy to other attendees)

#### CANDIDATE APPLICATION

- Do not be secretive. Answer honestly any questions the candidate has about the weekend or the movement (with the exception of palanca)
- ₱ Explain the Cursillo 4<sup>th</sup> Day (Group Reunion and Ultreya) to the candidate
- The cost of the weekend is approximately \$175. No one will be turned away because of finances. Inform the precursillo chairperson, in confidence, if your candidate is unable to pay for the weekend in full
- The Complete the application with your candidate and mail this completed Sponsor Commitment, the Candidate Application, and a \$50 (non-refundable) deposit to the precursillo chairperson.

  Note that Candidate Applications cannot be accepted without the submission of the Sponsor Commitment Form.
- ☼ Shortly after receipt of the application and Sponsor Commitment Form, the precursillo chairperson will e-mail the applicant a confirmation letter with further information about the weekend. You, as the sponsor will receive an e-mail as well. Check with your candidate that they received the e-mail and provide answers to any additional questions.

#### IN PREPARATION FOR THE CURSILLO WEEKEND

- Do palanca (pray and sacrifice) for your candidate
- Attend the Novena on Sundays from January 6 through March 3 at 1:00 PM, St. Joseph Freeburg Invite your candidate to attend a group reunion and Ultreya (prior to the weekend)

#### THE CURSILLO WEEKEND

- Insure your candidate has transportation to the Ruma Center. Candidates should not drive to the Cursillo site.
- ☼ Continue doing palanca for your candidate and all others attending the weekend
- Write a palanca letter to your candidate (indicate "Sponsor Letter" on the outside of the envelope) and give it to one of the team members prior to the start of the weekend
- Attend the Sunday evening closing and dinner, arriving at Ruma by 4:00 PM. Take your candidate home.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES FOLLOWING THE CURSILLO WEEKEND

- ★ Keep in close contact with your candidate, continuing to show as much interest as you did prior to the Cursillo, and encouraging them to persevere in their 4<sup>th</sup> Day
- Help your candidate find a sharing group
- → Attend the Cursillo Weekend Reunion with your candidate
- Accompany your candidate to Ultreya and School of Leaders

Upon receipt, a letter will be sent to your candidate with information about the weekend. And you will receive a letter with a reminder about a Palanca letter for your candidate, their transportation to and from Ruma, and your support of your candidate beyond the 3-day weekend.
