**CURSILLO COMMITTEE JOHN SCHABERG****Dear 4<sup>th</sup> Day Community, we'd like your advice:**

“What is the Cursillo Committee?” you may ask. These are the 4<sup>th</sup> Day Cursillistas who take on the job of Hospitality and Logistics, among other tasks. We are responsible for allowing the 3-day Weekends to happen, providing for the needs of the Teams and New Cursillistas, and making sure they are comfortable and open in mind and heart to what the Weekends can bring.

In July and August 2022, we had our challenges: lining up Prayer Angels for both Weekends (the first Weekends since 2019), the last-minute schedule changes at Kings House, the need to move the entire Women's Weekend to St. Henry's Parish Hall and Church on Sunday, the supply chain issues in getting Rosaries and Pilgrim's Guides, and potential problems with our Thursday and Sunday dinners. The Holy Spirit answered our prayers, moving many of us to pitch in with arms, legs, shoulders, and hearts, and all of those challenges were met with abundant blessings on our Movement. I would especially like to express my personal gratitude, and that of our Movement, to the Women's and Men's Stewards, to Sharon Gugliotta (Prayer Archangel), the Meal Angels (Margie Reaka, John and Bernadette Charlton, Cheryl Rajski, the Men's Team who helped the Women's Weekend “bug out,”) and many others who stepped up for these necessary tasks. (I apologize for not knowing all the good men and women who made these things happen without asking for any credit.)

**NOW, for the next challenges**, we ask for your prayers, your minds and hearts, and perhaps more arms and legs – **WE NEED A NEW HOME!!** As many of you know, both Kings House and the Sister House at Ruma have decided to close their retreat facilities. We pray for both of those communities as they move to the next chapter of their ministries, but the Belleville Diocesan Cursillo Community needs to find a suitable retreat center to host our Weekends in 2023 and beyond. **We need rooms for up to 40 or 50 people, dining and cooking facilities, a Chapel, one or two meeting rooms, and recreation and conversation spaces.** We have a huge, spread-out Diocese, and the logistics require us to transport the Team, the Candidates, and the Cursillo trailer of supplies to both Weekends. *So, if you can think of a retreat facility that might suit our needs*, please let me know, either email or call me (contact info in this issue).

**We also need a new place to park the Cursillo trailer.** We have stored it for many years at the home of Jeanette and the late Steve Schranz, but it sits alone in a field with no protection from the elements or the curious. We'd like to find a new home for the trailer to stay for the many months between our annual Weekends. *Again, if you have a space, or if you know of a space that might work, please let me know.*

**CURSILLO REGION IV NEWS** BERNADETTE CHARLTON

The Cursillo Movement is an international lay movement within the Catholic Church. In the United States it is broken down into twelve regions to facilitate and support the Cursillo Movement within all dioceses. Our Belleville Diocese is situated in Region IV. This region includes southern Illinois, southern Indiana, southern Ohio, southern Missouri and all of Arkansas, Kentucky, and Tennessee.

There are fifteen dioceses in Region IV. Each region has a Regional Service Team that consists of elected members from across the region. This Regional Service Team is responsible for the organization and management of their respective regions. They come together twice a year – once in the fall and once in the spring, offering programs and presentations dealing with current issues and spiritual subjects relating to Cursillo. The 2022 Region IV Fall Encounter is scheduled at The Fatima Retreat House in Indianapolis, IN on November 11 - 13. The 2023 Spring Encounter will be hosted by our own Belleville Diocese and will convene on March 24-26 at The National Shrine of Our Lady of the Snows.

This year two additional programs are being offered in Region IV. The Diocese of Evansville IN will convene a Cursillo de Cursillo on 13-15 January, and the Diocese of Covington, KY will convene a second Cursillo de Cursillo on 19-21 May. A Cursillo de Cursillo is a workshop based on the Foundational Charism of Cursillo. These workshops are open to all cursillistas.

Regional Encounters and Cursillo de Cursillos are high quality programs that offer attendees opportunities to commune with fellow cursillistas from across the Midwest, delving deeper into our Cursillo Charism. All cursillistas are welcome to attend!
