Dear Cursillistas.

I hope your Eastertide and return to the spring season are fulfilling and hopeful. This time between Easter and Pentecost gives us the unique, and might I say, rewarding time of prayer and reflection.

It is a unique time in our faith journey of knowing the presence of Christ, while at the same time often struggling to recognize Him in our routine or ordinary circumstances. 
