

FROM THE DIOCESAN CURSILLO COORDINATOR MARGIE REAKA

Happy New Year! No, you didn't miss Halloween, Thanksgiving and Christmas; I'm referring to a Cursillo New Year. Let me explain...

In our everyday life we use the Gregorian Calendar – starting each New Year on January 1.

Many businesses use a Fiscal Year calendar – starting their New Year on July 1.

As Christians and Catholics we use a liturgical calendar – starting the New Year on the first Sunday of Advent.

I'm proposing a Cursillo calendar – starting a New Year the month following completion of the Men's and Women's Weekends; this year it is September. I like that it gives us cause to review and reflect on what we accomplished and look forward to a new year filled with faith, friendship and evangelization.

Looking back over the past year...

• New Cursillistas: The 4th Day welcomed 30 new cursillistas from 15 parishes across the Belleville Diocese. Cheryl Rasjki, Rectora, and her team led 19 women and Father Harold Fischer, (on team as Spiritual Advisor) to make their Cursillo. John Schaberg, Rector, and his team led 11 men, including Deacon Arthur Hampton, making their Cursillo. In addition to the teams, about 50 angels from the 4th Day Community helped with the Prayer Vigil calls, Thursday evening dinners, Mananitas, and the Closing Potlucks.

We are so excited to have our newest cursillistas as part of our 4th Day! WELCOME!

• **Ultreyas:** Karen Davidson, Postcursillo Chairperson, organized two Grand Ultreyas this past year (September 28, 2024 and March 29, 2025) where many of the 4th Day came together to pray, hear a 4th Day witness, and share their friendship.

An Ultreya Committee was formed and they successfully revived the Cathedral Ultreya, which is now known as the Belleville Area Ultreya. The Belleville Area Ultreya, which began in April, is held monthly on the second Tuesday at St. Teresa Parish immediately following 5:30pm Mass.

The St. Agatha/St. Joseph Ultreya has become the St. Agatha/St. Joseph/St. John the Baptist Ultreya as St. John the Baptist, Smithton, began sharing hosting responsibilities. This Ultreya meets on the last Monday of the month at 7pm, alternating locations.

• **School of Leaders:** Under the leadership of Anna Feurer, School of Leaders meets monthly on the second Tuesday at 7pm. The majority of the year was spent reviewing National Cursillo articles on *Friendship*. Those who attended (ranging from long-time cursillistas to those who very recently made a Cursillo) were amazed at what they learned during the discussions.

- **Synodal Listening Session:** On August 20, xx 4th Day met at St. Agatha, New Athens to share and discuss their thoughts on the future of the Belleville Diocese from the perspective of Cursillistas. We were pleased to be a part of this diocesan initiative.
- **Prayer Requests:** Our Prayer Request Team sent out more than 100 prayer requests this past year. Our 4th Day who request prayers for their loved ones are comforted knowing more than 500 cursillistas are praying for their intentions.
- **Flocknote Emails:** In November 2024, we began sending Cursillo event notices to the 4th Day via Flocknotes. Michelle Massey creates and sends colorful, easier-to-read emails. We hope you are enjoying the new format.
- **CSMA Grant:** The Belleville Diocesan Cursillo was granted \$2100 from the Belleville Diocese Catholic Services and Ministry Appeal. The money was used to purchase updated Rector's Guides for team members' use, pay monthly Flocknote fees, and help with some Cursillo weekend costs.
- **Fundraising:** With increasing costs to Retreat Centers, the Secretariat launched a fundraising campaign in January to supplement some of the cost of the weekend for team members and religious. Thanks to many 4th Day who contributed as we raised more than \$2,500.
- The 4th Day: Throughout the year many of our 4th Day helped with setting up and bringing food to Grand Ultreyas, facilitating the monthly Ultreyas, sending prayer requests, sponsoring candidates, praying for our candidates, attending Mananitas and Closings, and continuing to spread information about Cursillo. There are too many to mention by name (and I hesitate to mention names as someone may be inadvertently missed). Please know, we couldn't do it without you.

The upcoming year:

The Secretariat has several initiatives for the upcoming year, with the most important being the Men's and Women's Weekends. We are pleased that both 2026 weekends will be held at the King's House at Our Lady of the Snows.

The Ultreya committee is committed to adding one or two ultreyas in the southern regions of our diocese as well as in Clinton County and plans are well underway for a Grand Ultreya on October 18, 2025.




